Legal Responsibilities of a Board Director

1

Duty of Care

Board directors must exercise reasonable care when handling the business of the organization. Directors must actively participate and stay informed about the organization's activities.

2

Duty of Loyalty

Board directors must prioritize the interests of the organization over personal or professional interests. Directors must disclose conflicts and make decisions aligned with the prosperity of the organization.

3

Duty of Obedience

Board directors must comply with all applicable laws and adhere to the organization's bylaws. Directors must ensure the organization upholds its purpose and mission.



Board and Staff Roles

Board of Directors

The primary role of the board of directors is to govern the organization. The board shapes the trajectory by setting strategic direction that aligns with the organization's purpose and mission. The board provides oversight, ensures resources and fulfills fiduciary duties.



Organization Staff

Staff are at the forefront of the organization's activities and drive the day-to-day management of the institution. Staff carry out operations, execute plans, implement initiatives and report on outcomes related to the organization's strategy.
