4-H Program

- Speaker's goal is to make people outside the agricultural community aware that they can be part of it without raising animals.
- The show on Sunday was a terminal sale, meaning animals are committed to going dormant.
- Businesses like Golden Rule are huge supporters and buy the animals.
- People can buy a share of an animal and donate it to a group.

Butcher Process

- Parents and past parents meet early in the morning to block butcher slots.
- People can bid, turn in their cut sheet, pay, and leave.
- Your fish got a \$5,000 grant and bought three hogs to put back in their pantry.
- The hogs cost \$4 a pound, but it is tax deductible.

Community Theater

- Laurie Bursack encourages people to see Jersey Boys, which is based on the life of Frankie Valli.
- Katie Miner's daughter, Jolie, is in the show.

- Speaker prefers not to "steal people from the groups because then you have a loyalty quandary to deal with."
- Speaker mentions "gang fights" and "turf wars" as a reason to avoid stealing people from groups.

Pest Control Referral

- Speaker did a "soft referral" to UVA Credit Union for their pest control guy who banks with Navy Federal
- The pest control guy is a "one man shop" who removes squirrels and bats from attics, and will handle snakes if necessary.
- Speaker will pass along UVA Credit Union's information to him.
- The pest control guy helped with a termite issue that the lawn people caused.

Hospice of the Piedmont Golf Tournament

- Speaker has been associated with the Hospice of the Piedmont Golf tournament for 20 years.
- There are two team spots open this year for \$800 per team of four on May 23rd (Friday before Memorial Day) at Falkir Springs.
- Speaker is selling 50/50 raffle tickets for \$100 each, with a total of 300 tickets sold and a payout of \$15,000 if all tickets are sold.
- Hospice of the Piedmont "pretty much mirrors the footprint of UVA Credit Union."
